


Assessed Control of Terrain in Ukraine and Main Russian Maneuver Axes as of August 16, 2023, 3:00 PM ET




Battle for Bakhmut

Assessed Control of Terrain Around Pyatykhatky and Robotyne as of October 6, 2023, 3:00 PM ET











Ukraine applied for EU membership in February 2022 and was granted EU candidate status in June 2022



American Politics


- Bipartisan support in the Senate, same in the US House of Representatives but smaller %.

Bilateral aid to Ukraine between January 24, 2022, and July 31, 2023




How Aid to Ukraine Compares to Other U.S. Spending

US Support for Ukraine

- Declining
- Strongest among Democrats, followed by Independents and least by Republicans. Majority of Congress support Ukraine
- President Biden proposes a single package of \$90B in FY2024
