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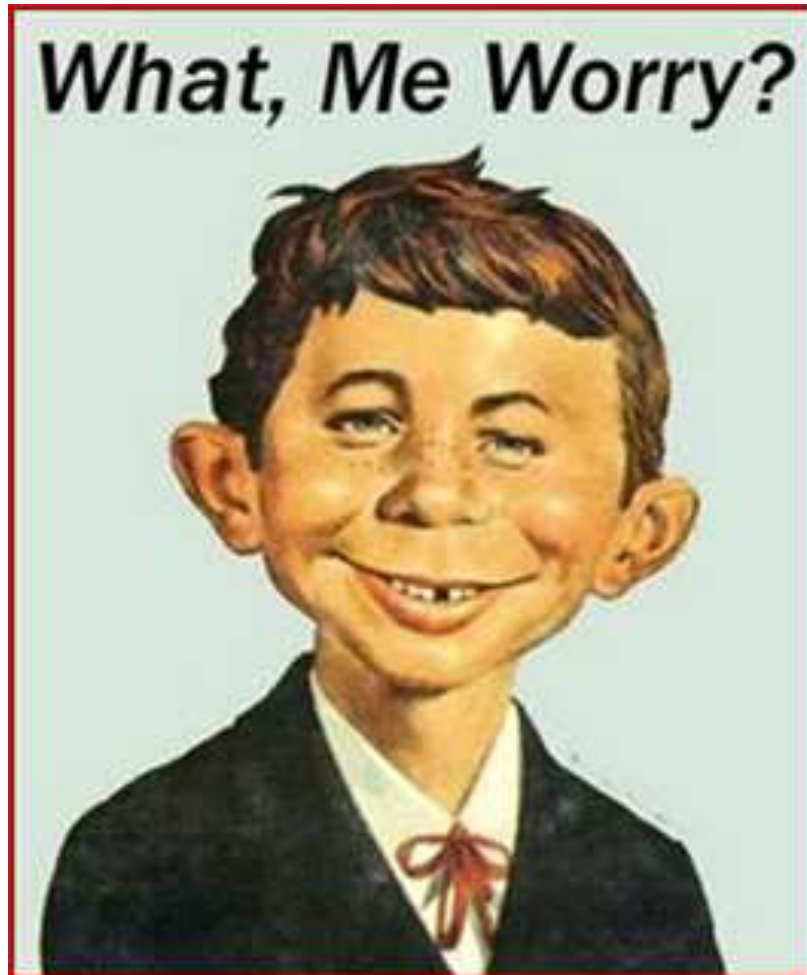

What is the damage that can result?

- Receiving spam email from others
 - Loss of privacy
 - Inconvenience, embarrassment
 - Possible malicious attachments
- If your account is broken into
 - Login and password allows “Hacker” to do anything your login allows (more next slide)

If your password is known-

- Send mail (Spam) from your account
- Read your mail (info for identity theft)
 - Try to use same password elsewhere
- Try to reset password in financial accounts
 - Reset authorization via your email
 - Use security question for protection

- In your phone or mobile device

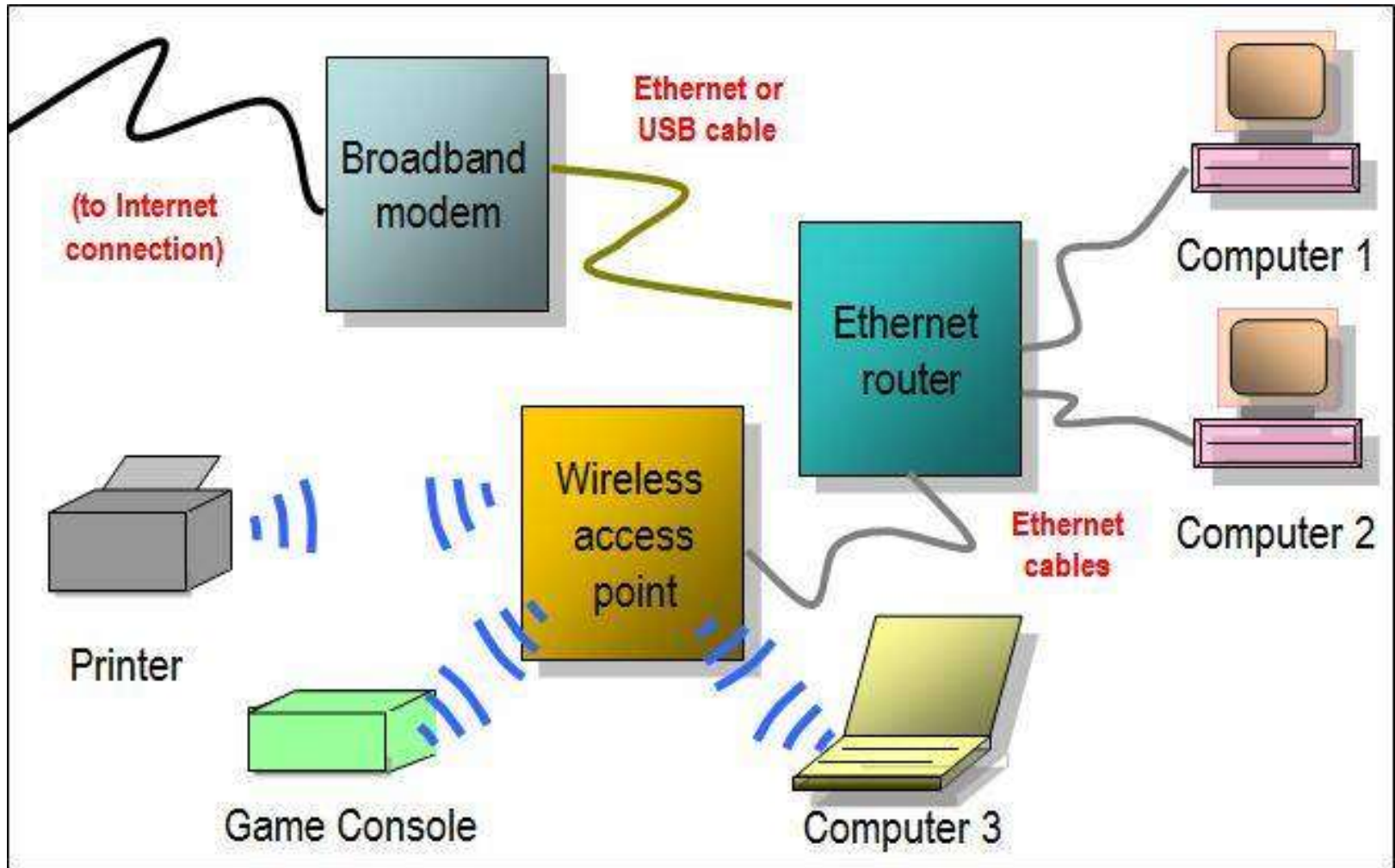
In your email (context)

- Harvest distribution lists

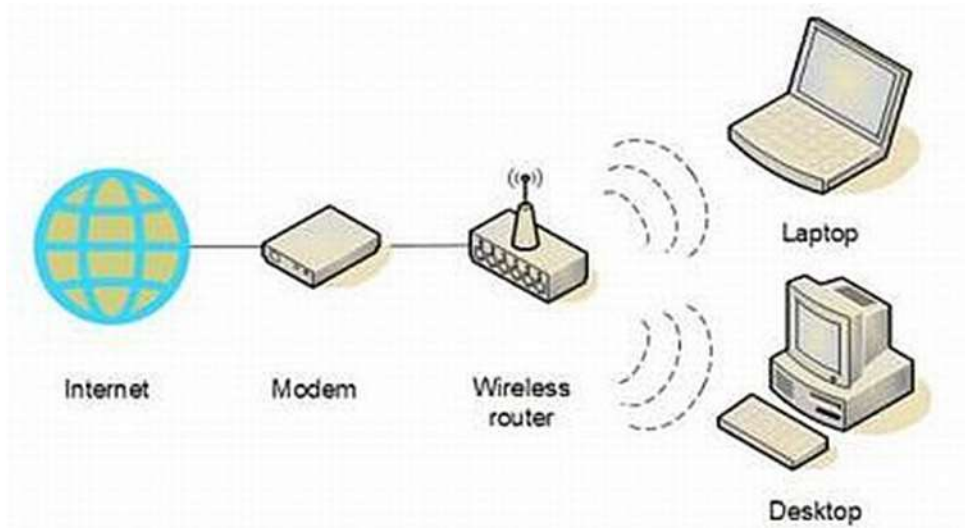
How could it get hacked?

How do you get connected?

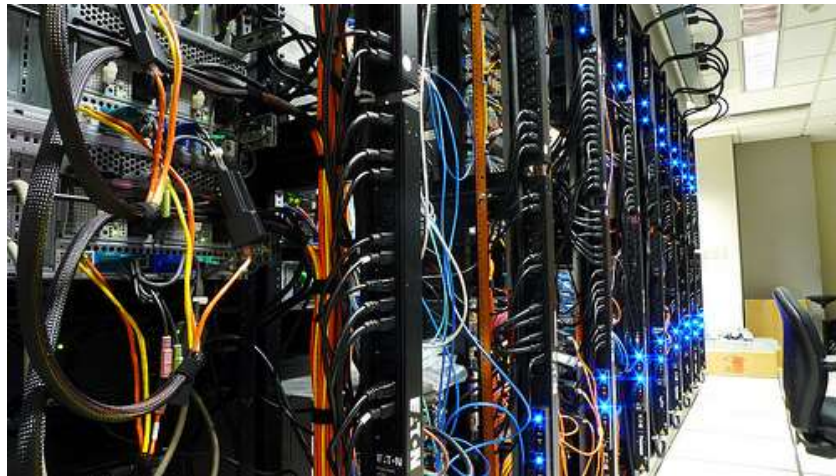
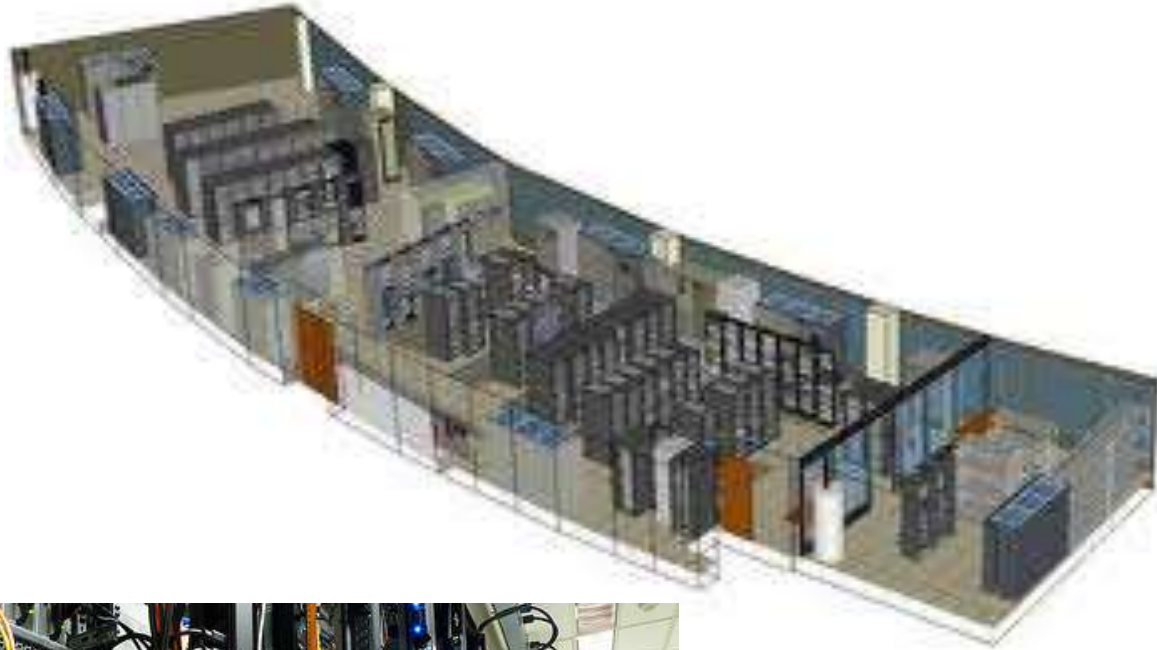




How do you get connected to the Internet?

How could it get hacked?

- Guess your password
- Break into your equipment
- Steal your cellphone
- Eavesdrop on insecure connection - public wi-fi - open unknown router

Malware on your computer

- Key loggers
- Snooping programs

- Protection
 - Anti-virus
 - Firewall
 - Etc.

Server break-in

eBay, Amazon, your bank have large IT/security staff
A small business may not have good electronic security

WI-FI Security

- Eavesdrop on insecure connection
- public wi-fi
- open unknown router
- Make sure network is not accessible

What can you do to protect it?

- Limit exposure
- Avoid saving data
- Firewalls, anti virus, etc.
- Use multiple addresses
- Change password
- Hard to guess password
- Limit password scope
- Use bcc, don't broadcast distribution lists
