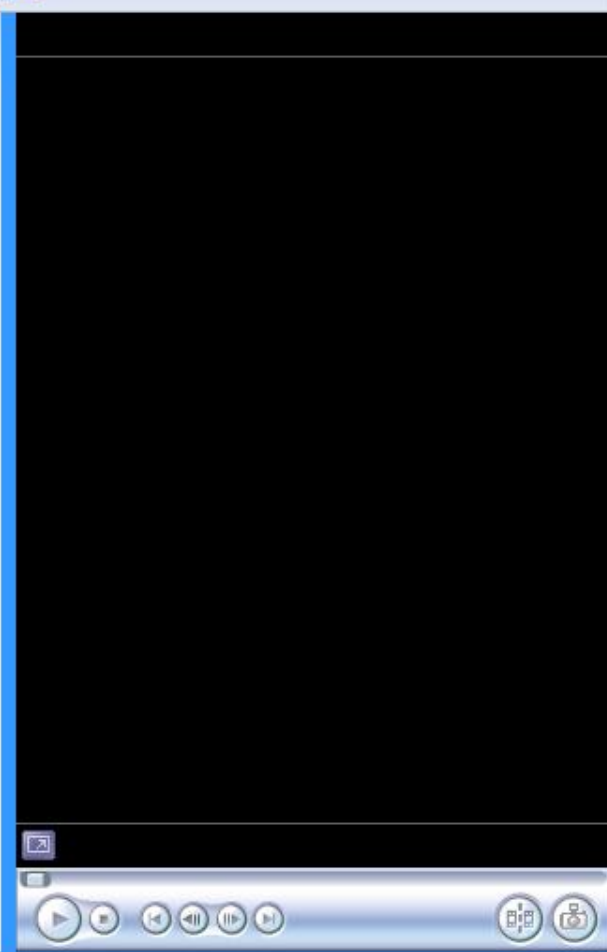

- Title
- Opening
- Start with Impact
- Mix of stills and videos
- Add audio
 - Introduction
 - Music
 - Description
- End
