


# Formats Available



# **Two Databases of Titles**

- OverDrive Digital Media Catalog
  - Subscription via Minuteman Library Network
  - Cary has additional "Advantage" titles
  - Many publishers of e-books and e-audiobooks
- <u>Recorded Books</u>
  - Subscription via Cary Library
  - Exclusive publisher: Recorded Books Audio
- Both services intended for home use

# Minuteman's OverDrive Configuration

#### Various Limits

- Checkout Limit: 3 titles at a time, per patron
- Maximum items in a cart: 5
  - Note: Items in a cart are not available for other patrons
- Cart Expiration: 30 minutes
  - After this time the items are removed and put back into circulation
- Waiting List Pickup Period: 5 days
  - After this time expires, the title becomes available to the next patron on the waiting list or is put back into circulation.
- Waiting List Limit: 3 titles

# Minuteman's OverDrive Configuration, continued

#### **Lending Periods**

- MP3 Audiobooks: Default = 7 days, with option for 14
- WMA Audiobooks: Default = 7days, with option for 14
- Adobe EPUB eBooks: Default = 14 days, with options for 7 or 21 days
- Adobe PDF eBooks: Default = 14 days, with options for 7 or 21 days
- Mobipocket eBooks: Default = 14 days, with options for 7 or 21 days


# Browse, Search for, and Download Titles

- To a PC or Mac
  - Read from computer screen, or
  - Transfer to a mobile device: Nook, Sony eReader, Kobo, etc.

### AND/OR

• Search and Download directly to your mobile device: iPhone, iPod, iPad, Blackberry, etc.

# **Cary Library's Recorded Books**

## Recorded Books •

Unabridged editions of downloadable audiobooks. These books may be played on compatible MP3 players (players that support WMA DRM), but can not be burned to CD. eAudiobooks in MP3 format can be played on iPods.



# **Recorded Books Configuration**

### **Checkout Limits**

*E-Audiobooks:* 10 titles at a time, per patron

Publicly-accessible E-books: 50 titles at a time, per patron

### Lending Periods

*E-Audiobooks:* 3 weeks; may be renewed once

Publicly-accessible E-books: View online 15 minutes; check out for 1 week

## **Recorded Books: How-To**



- Log in. (Create an account on the NetLibrary website; Different from your library barcode/PIN)
- Search for and download eAudiobooks to your computer, choosing the right file format. Look at the icons! No direct downloads; titles must be transferred to your mobile device via Windows Media Player or iTunes. <sup>(3)</sup>
- Play using Windows Media Player, iTunes (eAudiobooks in MP3 format only), or another portable listening device.

Get an e-card online

- Merrimack Valley Library Consortium: Burlington, Billerica, Carlisle, etc.
  - Get a card with a MVLC barcode; must show your MLN card
- North of Boston Library Exchange: Stoneham, Melrose, etc.
  - Get a card with a NOBLE barcode; must show your MLN card
