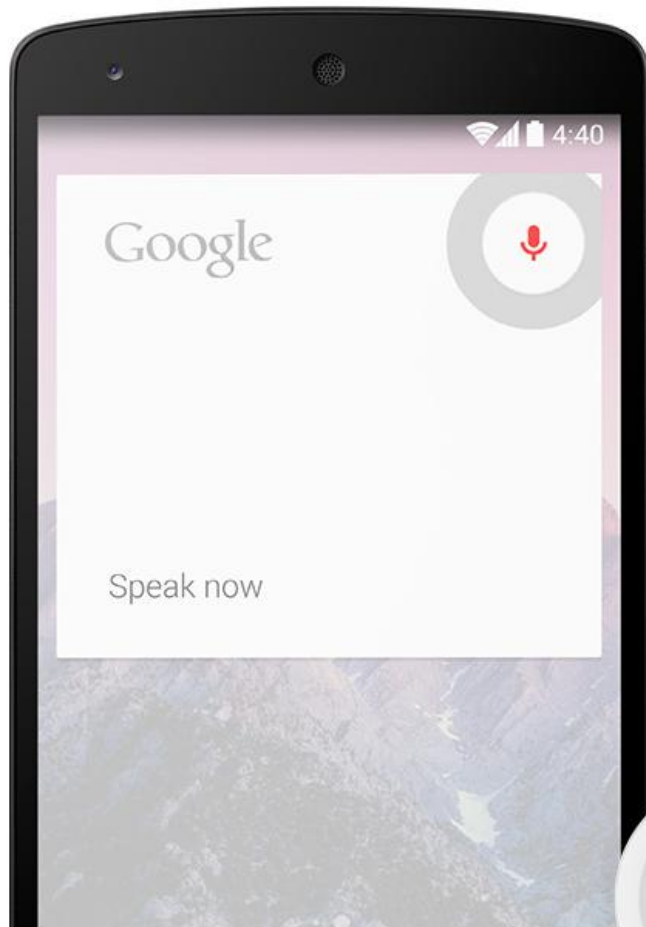

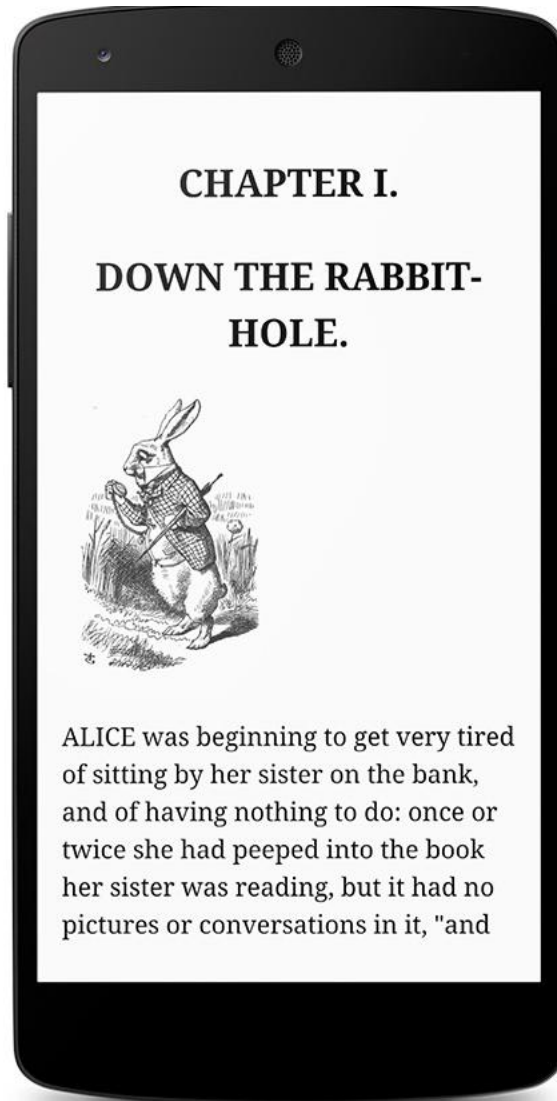


Just say "Ok Google"

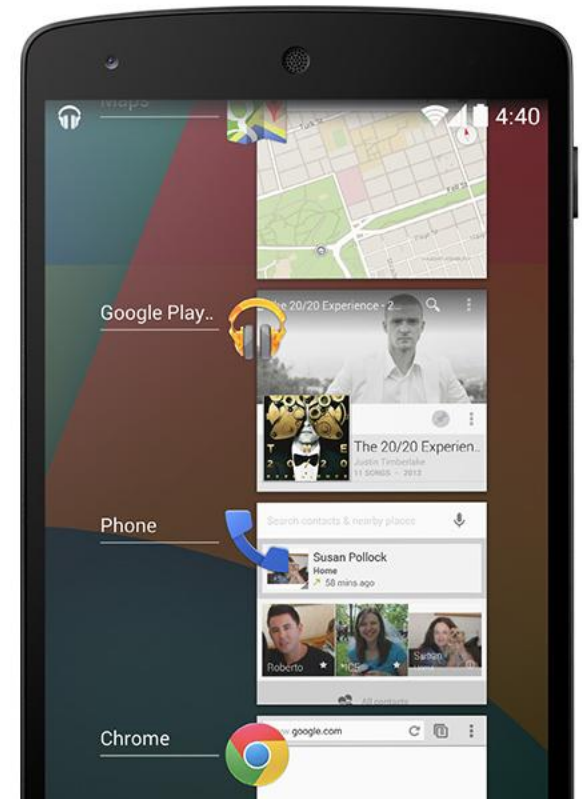

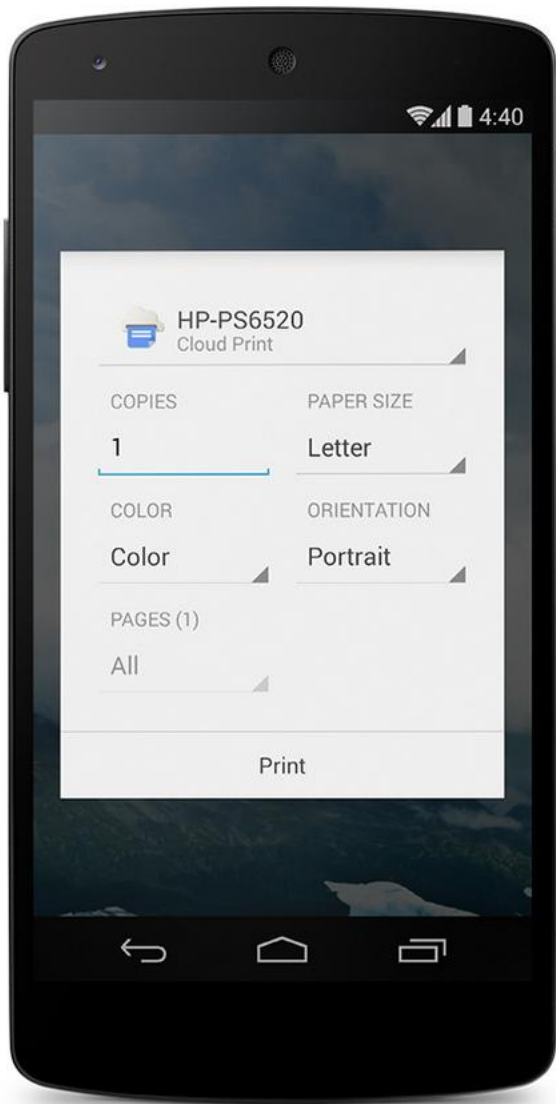

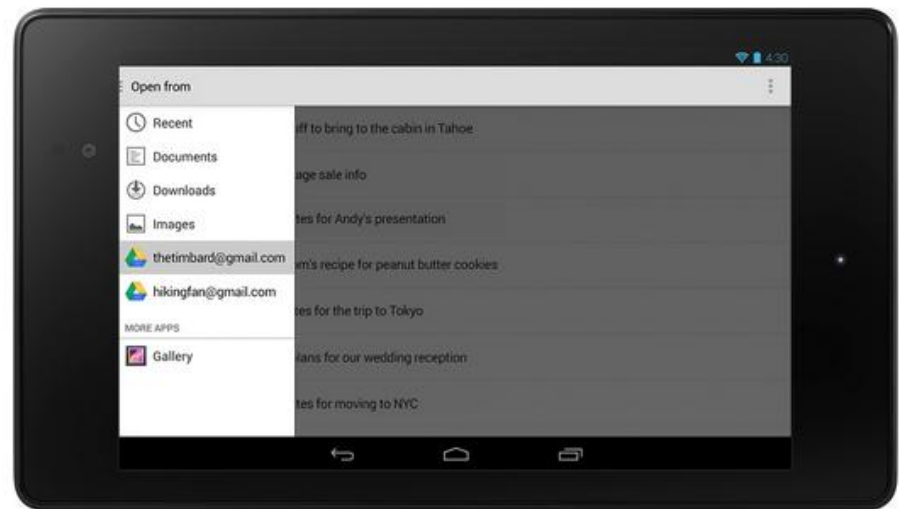
Print wherever, whenever

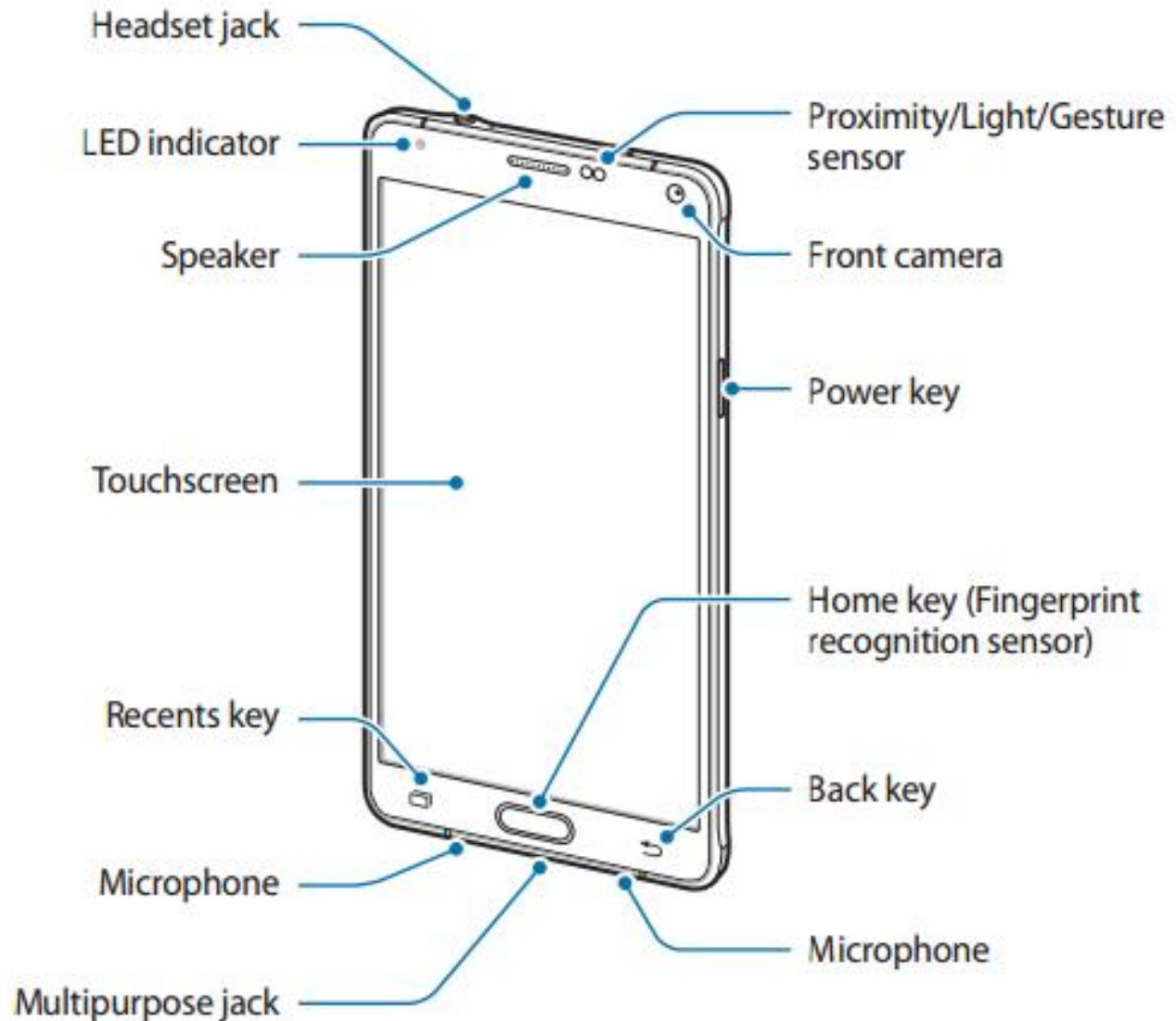

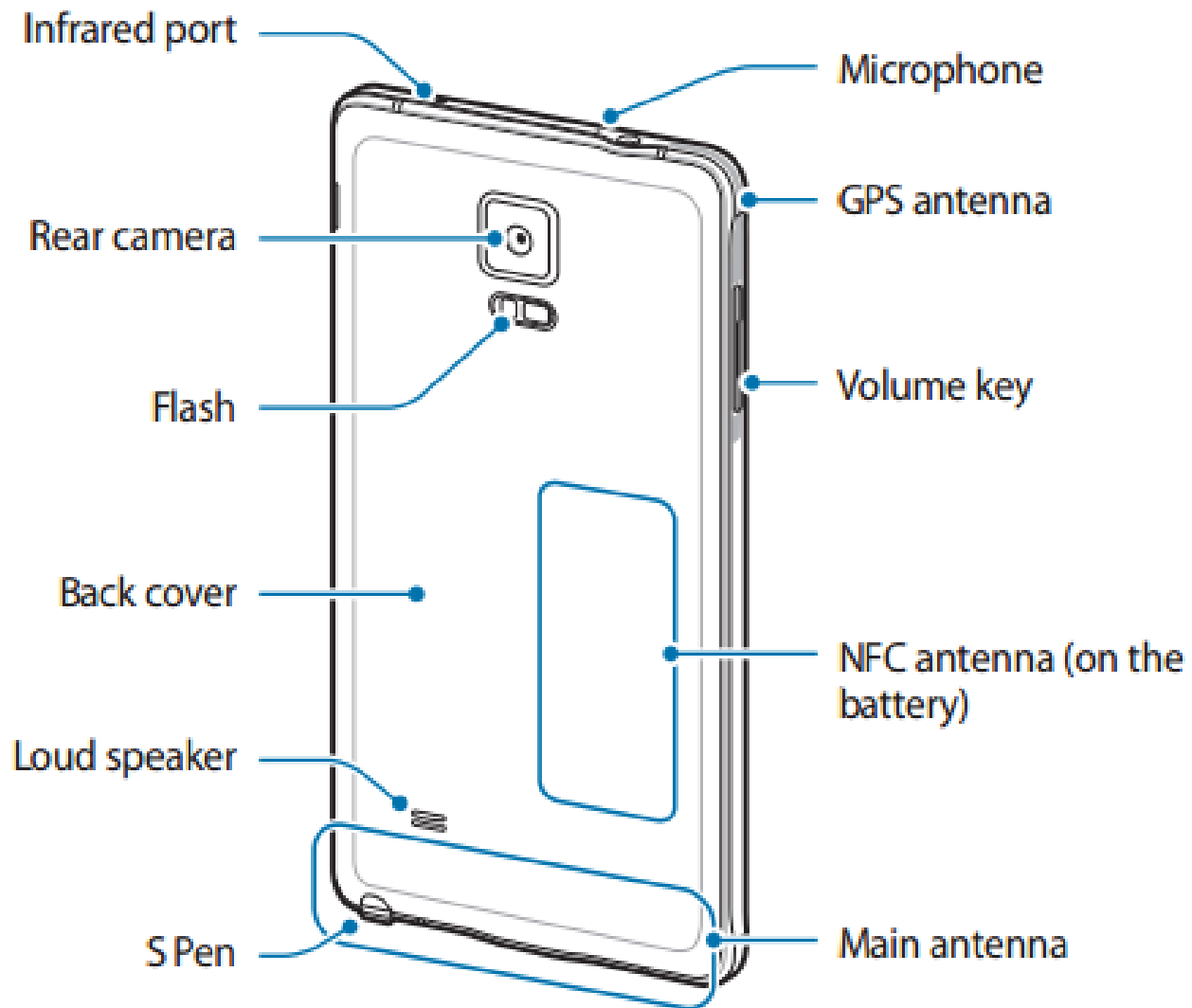

Front Layout



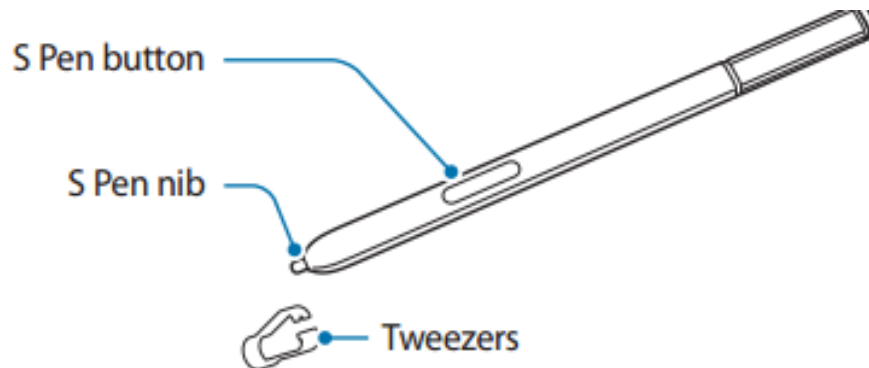

Key	Function
 Power	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Press and hold to turn the device on or off.• Press to turn on or lock the screen.
 Recents	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Tap to open the list of recent apps.• Tap and hold to access additional options for the current screen.
 Home	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Press to turn on the screen while the screen is locked.• Press to return to the Home screen.• Press twice to launch S Voice.• Press and hold to launch Google.
 Back	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Tap to return to the previous screen.
 Volume	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Press to adjust the device volume.

S Pen



Name	Functions
S Pen nib	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use the S Pen to write, draw, or perform touch actions on the screen.• Hover the S Pen over items on the screen to access additional S Pen features, such as Air Button and the air view feature.
S Pen button	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Hover the S Pen over the screen and press the S Pen button to display the air command features.• While pressing and holding the S Pen button, drag the S Pen over items to select them.
Tweezers	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Remove the S Pen nib with the tweezers when replacing the nib.

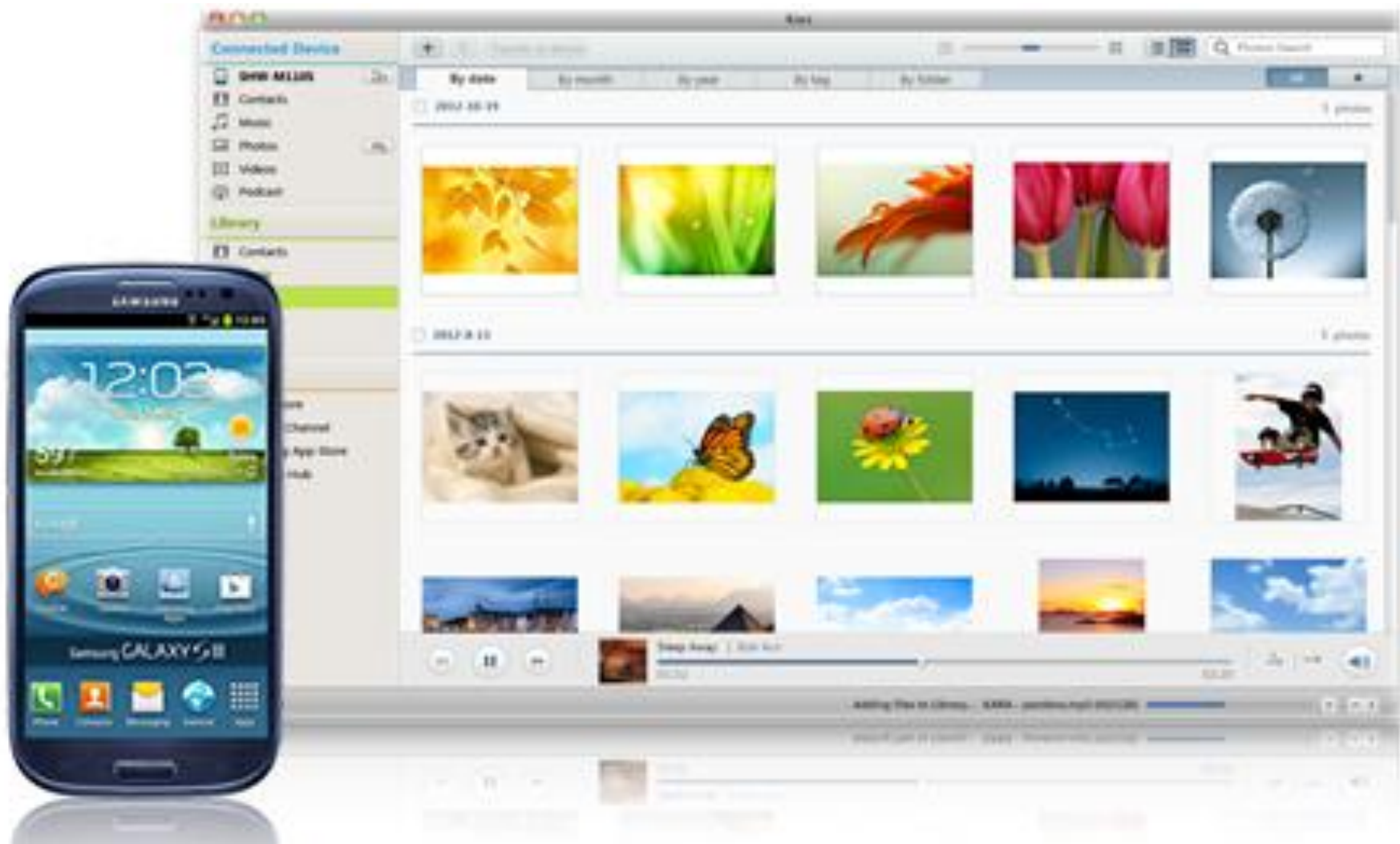

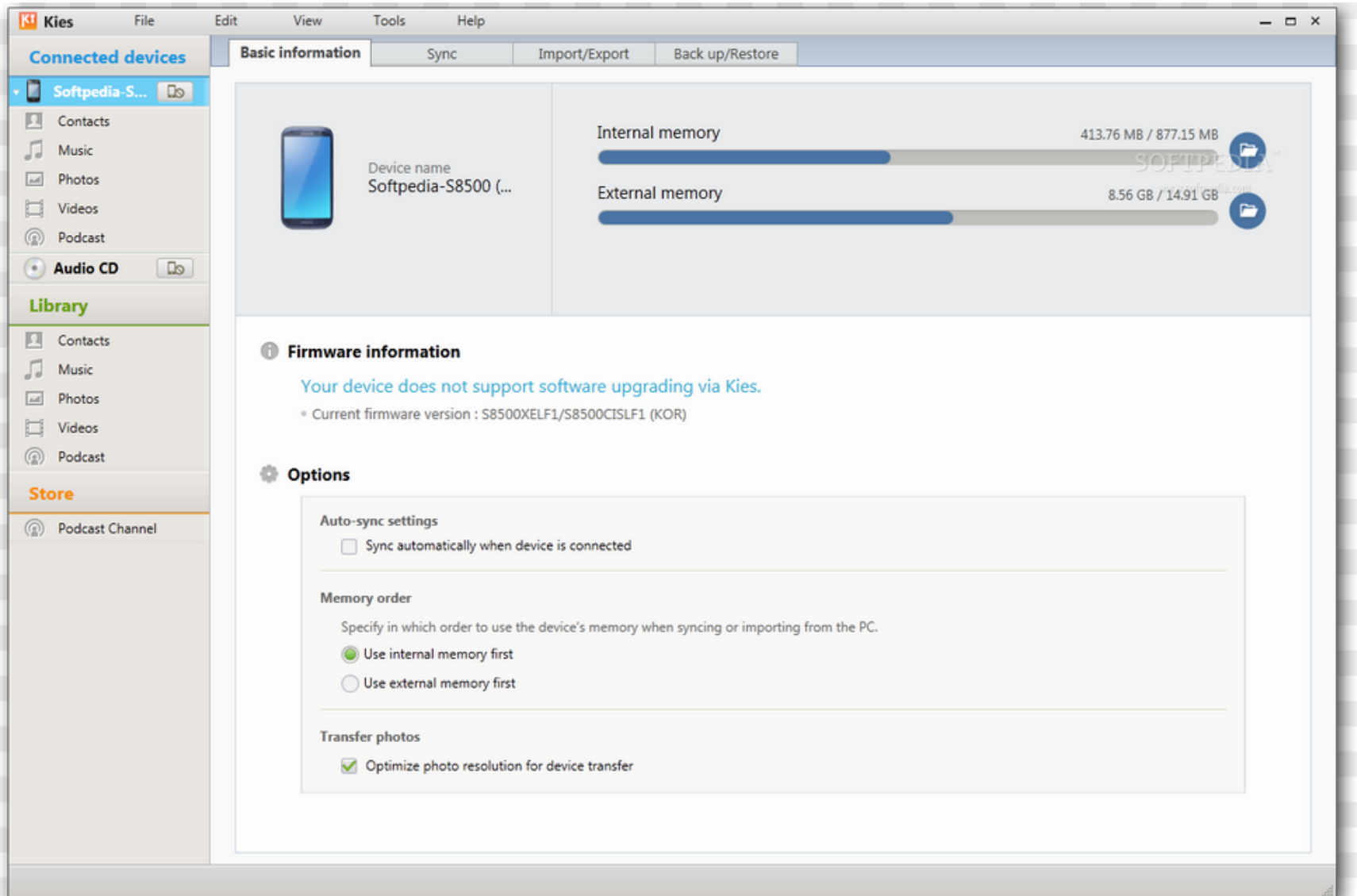
